

SUMMER 2023 SPACE STEM CAMP APPLICATION

Due April 15, 2023

Thank you for your interest in the first Chautauqua County Space STEM Camp, to be held July 17 - 21, 2023, at Falconer Central Schools and the Martz-Kohl Observatory in Frewsburg, NY. The day camp is open to students residing in Chautauqua County entering grades 6 - 9 in the 2023-24 school year.

Directions: Please review and complete the entire form. A parent or guardian should complete the information sections. The student is required to answer the five questions on their own and indicate by signing the application that they are the author of the written responses. This can be completed on the computer or by printing a hard copy.

Due Date: The completed form and payment is due no later than April 15, 2023. Applications can be sent via email to mplumb@falconerschools.org with the subject line "Space STEM Camp Application," or mailed to/dropped off at Falconer Central Schools, 2 East Avenue North, Falconer NY 14733. Mailed/delivered applications must be received (not postmarked) by April 15, 2023.

Teacher Recommendation: The teacher recommendation form (LINKED HERE) should be provided to the teacher as soon as possible, so the teacher is able to return the form via email to mplumb@falconerschools.org by April 15, 2023.

Payment: A \$20 application fee is required with the application. There are two payment options for the fee. Refunds will be processed if a student does not receive a camp slot.

Selection criteria: We anticipate more applicants than we have space to offer. We are offering 25 camper slots. A waiting list will be established, and if space opens, we will notify people on the waiting list. Those not securing slots will be refunded the \$20 deposit. Selection criteria include:

- 1) A completed application and all required information is provided by the due date
- 2) \$20 application fee is received by the due date
- An effort will be made to include representation from as many school districts as possible
- 4) Student written responses to questions in the application
- 5) Teacher recommendation (Email this <u>LINK</u> to a teacher you have this year, who will complete the recommendation. The teacher must complete the recommendation using their school email address by April 15, 2023.)
- 6) Student Zoom interview will be scheduled in mid-April. Students should be prepared to speak in more detail about their written answers to application questions. Interviews will be approximately 10 minutes long.
