Welcome! Please complete this form to register for the 2nd annual Chautauqua County Space STEM Camp. Registration opens on March 1, 2024, and will continue until the 24 slots are filled. A registration is complete when this form is completed and submitted with supporting documentation, and registration payment of \$50.00 per child is received by the Martz-Kohl Observatory.

We anticipate it will take you 20 minutes to complete this registration.

As registrations are submitted, they will be confirmed via email every two weeks starting on March 15th. Once capacity is reached, those registering in spots 25 and higher will be notified of their place on a waiting list and registration fees will be refunded if a camp spot is not available.

If there are multiple children in one family registering, a separate form must be completed for each child.

Registration is open to students residing in Chautauqua County and entering Grades 7 - 9 in September 2024. Students who do not attend public school but reside in Chautauqua County will be required to submit immunization records for review to the Falconer Central School Health Office before their registration is accepted.

Students who attended camp last year will be placed (in order of registrations received) on a wait list for returning campers, in case spots are not filled by new campers.

There will be mandatory meetings for parents of the 24 confirmed campers to attend either via Zoom or in person at Falconer Central Schools. Please mark your calendars now for the evening of April 29th or May 2nd at 7 p.m.
